Any statements that you create are displayed with a pale yellow background, after the statutory columns (which are displayed with a green background) and before the non-statutory guidance columns (which are displayed with a pale blue background) on the **Programme of Study Tracking Entry** grid.

Defining the Display Order of Statements

An additional menu route that enables the collection of a new statutory requirement to provide a Baseline Assessment (BA) has been provided, in addition to the Foundation Phase Outcomes (FO).

This is supported by the statutory introduction of the Foundation Phase Profile, which is an observation-based assessment tool that supports summative assessment of children throughout the Foundation Phase from September 2015 onwards.

The statutory areas of learning (AoL) for the Foundation Phase Baseline Assessments are:

- Personal and social development, well-being and cultural diversity (PSD)
- Language, literacy and communication skills (LCW or LCE)
- Mathematical development (MDT)
- Physical development (PDT).

The Foundation Phase Baseline Assessment assesses a child's abilities in these four areas of learning. The assessment should be carried out within the first six weeks of the pupil starting school in the Reception year.

Please note that if a Bronze 'Z' value has been entered in the Foundation Phase Baseline Assessment template for either the Reciting and sequencing numbers (MDT) or the Drawing (PDT) areas of learning, this grade must be replaced with a valid grade <u>before</u> the updated resources for the SIMS 2016 Spring Release are imported.

To enable schools to create reports based on cohorts so that items collected in the Attendance Collection Return (e.g. pupil premium) can be tracked, a new sub-report has been made available.

The new Statutory Return sub-report is located in the Student data area (last node). Three options are available for selection under the sub-report: **Authorised Date**, **File Name** and **Description**.

In the **Find Student** browser, a new column called **YTI** (Year Taught In) has been provided, enabling the sorting of students based on the year in which they are taught.

A number of additional columns have been added to the Detailed report output to facilitate the interrogation of Progress 8 data. These are called No. Att 8 English, No. Att 8 Maths, No. Att 8 Other Ebacc, No. Att 8 Open and Est. Attain 8. For clarity, some existing column headings have been renamed; the Attain 8 column is now called Attain 8 Score, the Progress 8 column is now called Progress 8 Score and the Score column is now called Total Score. A column has also been provided for the display of Best 8 records.

Full Report Output

Additional columns have been added to the Full report output to facilitate the interrogation of Progress 8 data. These are called Counted in EBacc, Counted Att.8 - English, Counted Att.8 - Maths, Counted Att.8 - EBacc and Counted Att.8 - Other.

The columns called L3 Entry and L3 A*-E have been removed because they are no longer required.

Incorrect Discounting of QANs and AS Results Not Counted at KS4

When running the KS4 English Reports in the Summer 2016 season, there are some QANs that will be discounted incorrectly. Additionally, some AS results will not be counted at KS4. This issue will be resolved with the new Performance Measures file that will be provided as part of the SIMS 2016 Summer Release.

New National Insurance Rules for Apprentice Employees Under 25

Focus | Personnel Links | Salary Projection Focus | Personnel Links | Salary Calculator

From 6 April 2016, the National Insurance employer's Class 1 secondary contribution will not be required for Apprentice employees under the age of 25 on earnings up to the upper earning level for the employee. The employer's contribution will be calculated from the 1st of the month in which the employee becomes 25. To ensure that Personnel Links accurately projects the National Insurance contribution for all employees, it is critical that the date of birth held in Personnel is accurate and that the employee is identified as an apprentice in the employee's contract. Additionally, within Salary Calculator, the **Apprenticeship Scheme** check box has been added to the contract to indicate that the employee's contract relates to an apprenticeship scheme for the duration of the financial year.

Recording General Notes Against a Supplier

Focus | Accounts Payable | Supplier

It is now possible to add general notes to a supplier via the **Supplier Details** page. This is achieved by clicking the **Notes** button on the Focus Bar.

Selecting a Specific Financial Period when Running the Salary Projection Report

It is now possible to select a financial period when running the salary projection reports, enabling you to identify variations between commitments and actuals.

Retirement of Old Detailed Supplier Account Status Report Format

School Details Displayed on the Title Bar

The Title Bar in FMS now indicates the school's name, together with their LA/Establishment Number.

Home Page

Implementation of the Admissions Summary Panel

A new widget (Admissions Summary) can now be added to the SIMS Home Page. This enables a quick view of the current number of applications by application status (e.g. Applied, Offered, Accepted) in a bar chart format. The widget can be configured to allow the comparison of two time periods. To display more specific information, you can drill down into the data by double-clicking the bars of the chart.

Addition of Admissions Summary to Home Page Group Configuration Settings

The YTI (Year Taught In) column has been added to all instances of the Find Student browser where the Status, Tier, Year Group, Reg Group/Class and House drop-down lists are displayed. Generic Management is identified by the number 7 in the <u>third</u> digit of the DENI number.

Please note that this feature can be used only when an on-request patch has been installed by C2K.
