Please read these notes carefully before installing or upgrading your software. Do not attempt any installation or upgrade without first making a fully restorable backup of your SIMS system. For instructions on how to do this, please go to the SIMS backup section of our website (<http://www.capita-sims.co.uk/backupsims>).

Capita SIMS has made this release note available in PDF and Word formats. To take full advantage of the functionality available in this release note (e.g. links to handbooks and video tutorials), you must use the PDF version. Capita SIMS cannot be held responsible for any changes, errors or omissions resulting from subsequent editing of the supplied document.

### Important Information – please read before upgrading

If you are performing a SIMS upgrade spanning more than one release, it is essential that you read the release note associated with each version.

#### End of Support for SQL Server 2008

**From the SIMS 2015 Summer Release onwards, SIMS, FMS, Discover, SLG, Partnership Xchange, SOLUS and InTouch run on SQL Server 2012 and SQL Server 2014 only. These products are no longer supported on SQL Server 2008 or SQL Server 2008 R2. For more information on support for SQL Server, please refer to the SIMS Technical Roadmap on My Account (<https://myaccount.capita-cs.co.uk>).**

#### SIMS Services Manager

From the SIMS 2014 Autumn Release, the SIMS Services Manager (SSM) has been incorporated as part of the upgrade process. SSM is installed automatically and silently on the SIMS SQL Server as part of the server upgrade process and installs .NET Framework 4.5.2. The standard reboot that normally occurs as part of the .NET installation has been suppressed and will not occur automatically. Likewise, in order to protect the SIMS upgrade and to avoid causing alarm, if there are any issues with the installation of SSM or the .NET Framework, no error messages will be displayed and the rest of the SIMS upgrade will proceed as normal.

To enable the successful installation of these components, there must be 2Gb of free disk space available on the SIMS SQL Server.

If you run the upgrade manually and do not want SSM to be installed, please use the switch **/NoServicesManager** when you run **SIMSSQLApplicationSetup.exe**. The text in the switch is case sensitive.

#### Examinations Organiser

From the SIMS 2014 Spring Release, we have included the Microsoft Report Viewer as part of the workstation upgrade process. This is used by the reporting functionality for Examinations Organiser provided with that release. If the Report Viewer upgrade is taking an excessive amount of time and you decide not to install it, a user with Administrative rights can save time by running the SIMS workstation upgrade (**SIMSApplicationSetup.exe**) via the Command Line, using the **/NoReportViewer** switch. Taking this action means that you will have to install the Report Viewer at a later date. FMS users already have this option as part of the FMS upgrade process.

#### B2B

If you use B2B, and you want the SQL Server service to be configured to run as a Domain account instead of the built-in LocalSystem account on Windows 2008 R2 or Windows 2012 Server, a separate patch can be run to enable this functionality. This patch is available from your Local Support Unit (Patch 20419) and it must be applied to your SIMS database by a user with System Administrator permissions.

#### SQL 2014 Migration

From the SIMS 2014 Autumn Release onwards, we support SIMS, FMS, Discover, SLG, Partnership Xchange, SOLUS 3.8 and InTouch on SQL 2014.

To facilitate server migration, a SQL Migration Tool is available. Please note that you must be running the SIMS 2014 Autumn Release or later before running the Migration Tool.

The Migration Tool assists with the migration of the SQL databases for SIMS, FMS and Discover. It enables you to install a SQL 2014 Express Edition instance and migrates the SIMS, FMS and Discover databases to the new database server. You are strongly advised to read the *Migrating SIMS, FMS and Discover to SQL 2014* handbook, which will be available from My Account (<https://myaccount.capita-cs.co.uk>) on product release.

If you are a SOLUS<sup>3</sup> user then you can migrate your SOLUS<sup>3</sup> system to SQL 2014 when you have upgraded to SOLUS 3.8.

For information on obtaining the Migration Tool, please contact your Local Support Team.

If you use both SIMS and FMS, both systems must be running on the same version of SQL Server, i.e. SQL Server 2012 or SQL Server 2014.

For more information on support for SQL Server, please refer to the *SIMS Technical Roadmap* on My Account (<https://myaccount.capita-cs.co.uk>).

#### General

Before upgrading to the SIMS 2015 Summer Release, you must ensure that the School Census Summer 2015 Return has been completed and signed off. Once you have upgraded to the SIMS 2015 Summer Release, it is not possible to carry out any further work on the Summer Return.

If your school uses both Fees Billing and FMS, SIMS and FMS must be upgraded at the same time.

#### **Upgrading using SOLUS**

The SIMS Online Update Service (SOLUS) enables you to download and run SIMS releases and patches via the Internet. This is achieved using **SOLUS3** or the **SOLUS2** Wizard.

For instructions on carrying out an upgrade with **SOLUS3**, please refer to the *SOLUS3 for System Administrators* handbook.

## Important Information for Windows 8 and Windows Server 2012 Users

If you are running SIMS on a Windows 8 or Windows Server 2012 workstation, you may encounter difficulties when attempting to open PDF files in SIMS. This is caused by Windows Reader being the default program used to open PDF files.

To resolve this issue, you must first ensure that Adobe Reader 9 or later is installed.

Next, you will need to associate Adobe Reader with all PDF files. From the Taskbar, click **File Explorer**, click **Computer** in the panel on the left-hand side of the page then from the Menu Bar, select **Computer | Open Control Panel**. Click **Programs | Default Programs | Associate a file type or protocol with a program**. In the **Extensions** list, scroll down to and click the **.pdf** item then click the **Change program** button. Click **Adobe Reader** then click the **Close** button.

## Backing up SIMS and FMS

Where SIMS Personnel is used to generate Salary Projections in FMS, SIMS and FMS backups should be carried out at the same time. If one of the databases needs to be restored, the other database must be restored to the same point, i.e. if you restore the SIMS database, you must restore the FMS database to the same point and vice versa.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Backups are no longer zipped, because of the number of issues caused by zipping backup files. Recent operating systems now allow the use of compressed folders, which are recommended for automatically compressing backups. Please refer to your operating system documentation for instructions on applying compression to a folder.

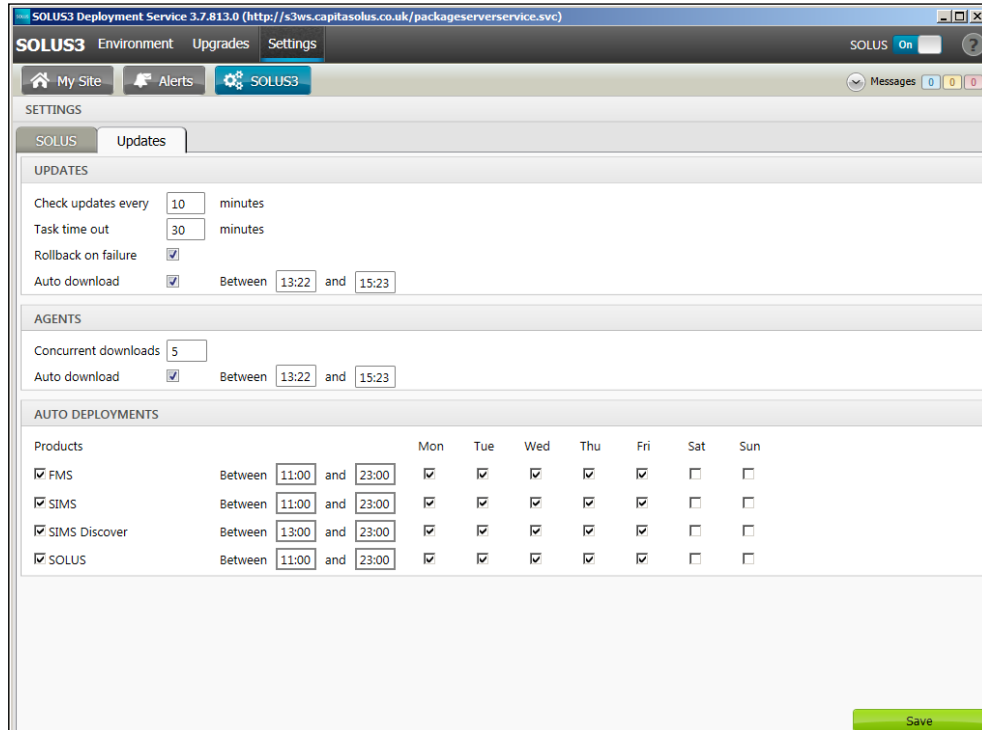
## Important Information Regarding the Upgrade of SIMS and Discover

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** You must upgrade to the SIMS 2015 Summer Release before upgrading Discover. If you upgrade Discover before upgrading SIMS, data will not be transferred between the SIMS and Discover databases until SIMS has been upgraded.

The person carrying out the installation of Discover must have Administrator permissions across the network.

## Auto-Deployment of SIMS and Discover

If SOLUS<sup>3</sup> auto-deployment is enabled for Discover, we recommend that the settings for Discover auto-deployment are set to start later than the SIMS auto-deployment start time plus the timeout.



If the times are not set like this, and the Discover deployment starts before the SIMS deployment, then the data transfer between SIMS and Discover will not work until the SIMS upgrade is completed.

## Important Information Regarding SIMS Documentation

Following valuable feedback from customers, the **Documentation Centre** was redesigned as part of the SIMS 2014 Spring Release, with a focus on enhancing the user's experience.

The principal benefit of the SIMS **Documentation Centre** is that resources for SIMS, FMS and Discover can all be accessed from a central repository.

It is still possible to search for user documentation by output type (handbook, tutorial, QRS, etc.) and then by functional area but now you can also search by role (e.g. Teacher, Administrator, Returns Manager, etc.).

A range of Frequently Asked Questions guides has been produced and can be accessed from the **FAQs** menu. The **Troubleshooting** section enables you to investigate any issues you may have when accessing the resources available.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** If you encounter issues when attempting to open any New Feature videos or Tutorials whereby you are asked to install the required version of Flash Player and/or an on-screen dialog suggests that Online Help content cannot be displayed, these can be resolved by downloading the latest version of Flash Player (<http://helpx.adobe.com/acrobat/kb/known-issues-acrobat-xi-reader.html>).

From the SIMS 2015 Spring Release, a search facility has been added to the SIMS, FMS and Discover Documentation Centres. This enables you to locate information across the Documentation Centres or within individual resources (handbooks, release notes, FAQs, etc.). The search facility operates in a similar way to a Google search. To perform a search, enter one or more keywords in the search field (located at the top right-hand side of the Menu Bar) then click the **Search** (magnifying glass) button. You can use \* and ? as wildcards. To search for an exact phrase, enclose more than one word in double quotes, e.g. "debit card".

To access the SIMS **Documentation Centre**, click the **Documentation** button on the **SIMS Home Page**.

This is caused by Windows Reader being the default program used to open PDF files.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** If you do not wish to access user documentation provided in PDF format via the web and instead continue to access it from the **\SIMS\Documentation** folder on your SIMS Server, this can be achieved by downloading a local version of our documentation set from the following location:

Once you have downloaded the file, unzip it to the **\SIMS\Documentation** folder on your SIMS Server. The downloaded documentation set is accessed by clicking the **Documentation** button on the **SIMS Home Page**.

Help files remain unaffected by this change in approach and continue to be delivered to the **\Program Files\SIMS\SIMS .net** folder on each SIMS workstation.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** If Google Chrome is your default web browser, please ensure you disable the Chrome PDF Viewer and enable the Adobe Acrobat plug-in to ensure that PDFs display correctly. This can be achieved by entering **chrome://plugins** in the Address Bar then pressing **Enter**.

It is now possible to import version 12.0 Admissions Data Transfer (ADT) files. It is also possible to import version 11.0.

For schools that use the Enquiries functionality, when an ADT file that contains applicants who were originally recorded as an enquiry is imported, the application is now linked to the enquiry. This enables you to produce conversion rates relating to enquiries that progressed into an application. The original enquiry record is also marked as inactive.

#### Enhancements to the School Report



##### *Reports | School Report*

An update has been provided to amend the way that KS2 Prior attainment is referenced in the SIMS School Report. Because schools can download their KS2 DL (Decimal Level) and FG (Fine Grade) results from the Key to Success website, two new aspects have been introduced to assist with the entering of this information and its storage in SIMS. These new aspects are used to drive the Progress 8 and Attainment 8 calculations in the SIMS School Report. An assessment template that enables schools to enter the data into the new aspects that are driving the calculations in the school report has also been provided.

The template file is called **Progress 8 – KS2 Fine Level Template** and it is available in the following folders in AMPARK as part of the SIMS 2015 Summer Release:

- **\AMPA\England Primary (and Middle Deemed Primary)\Assessment Manager**
- **\AMPA\England Secondary (and Middle Deemed Secondary)\Assessment Manager**.

The template is included for both Primary and Secondary schools so that Primary schools can enter the data against the aspects and then export the results, ready for import by a Secondary School.

### Fixes

- Pupils who have made no progress as shown in a **CAS Progress Aspect** analysis are now counted only in the **No Progress** column and no longer in the **Negative Progress** column (via [Focus | Assessment | Aspect Analysis](#)).

- When running individual reports, report sections with empty results are now hidden (via [Focus | Assessment | Individual Report](#)).
- When printing a selection of marksheets in System Utilities, the entire **Group Membership Date** field in the middle column of the **Marksheets - Print** page is now visible (via [Tools | Performance | Assessment | System Utilities | Marksheets](#)).
- When working in an Aspect Analysis, values now display correctly in cells when the **Rounding On** option is selected (via [Focus | Assessment | Aspect Analysis](#)).
- Marksheets that contain more than six fixed (additional student information) columns can now be printed from the **Template Details** page (via [Focus | Assessment | Template](#)).
- The course filter selected for a Progress Grid Template is now carried over correctly into Progress Grid Entry, resulting in the correct students being displayed; these are now the same students that are recorded in Course Manager (via [Focus | Assessment | Progress Grid Template | Progress Grid Entry](#)).
- The **Year** drop-down list on the **Programme of Study Tracking** page now displays only active years and no duplicates are now displayed (via [Focus | Assessment | Programme of Study Tracking Entry](#)).

The Update Course Memberships routine has been modified so that planned end dates for student memberships in years 10/11 and 12/13 are kept in line with a two-year duration setting for a course, as defined in the **Duration and Tolerance** panel. This means that student memberships no longer need to be protected and the **Protect** column in the **Memberships and Results** panel does not need to be ticked to prevent the Update Course Memberships routine from reversing any manual changes made to the planned end date.

The Update Course Memberships routine can now modify the planned end date automatically for any two-year courses as long as the **Protect** column has not been ticked.

- When a SEN status is recorded for a student and, on the same day, the status is changed back to **N**, the SEN history no longer displays a one day membership of the SEN status recorded via the first change (via [Focus | Student | Special Educational Needs](#)).
- When recording a new pupil/student, applicant or prospective pupil/student in SIMS, the search results displayed in the **Matched People** panel now exclude the names of members of staff (via various menu routes).
- When viewing names on the **Classes** list, the Preferred Forename and Preferred Surname are now displayed (via [Focus | Student | Student Details – Classes](#) in the **Links** panel).
