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### Welcome to the SIMS 2018 Autumn Release

Please read these notes carefully before installing or upgrading your software. Do not attempt any installation or upgrade without first making a fully restorable backup of your SIMS system.

Capita SIMS has made this release note available in PDF and Word formats. To take full advantage of the functionality available in this release note (e.g. links to handbooks and video tutorials), you must use the PDF version. Capita SIMS cannot be held responsible for any changes, errors or omissions resulting from subsequent editing of the supplied document.

# Important Information – please read before upgrading

If you are performing a SIMS upgrade spanning more than one release, it is essential that you read the release note associated with each version.

### Important Information for Schools in England

At the time this release note was produced, we had not yet received the validation and summary report files from the DfE for School Census Spring 2019 or School Workforce Census 2018. Schools should not provide their Return file to the DfE until they have imported a fileset that includes the official DfE validation and summary report files.

# **Upgrading using SOLUS**

The SIMS Online Update Service (SOLUS) enables you to download and run SIMS releases and patches via the Internet. This is achieved using SOLUS3.

For instructions on carrying out an upgrade with SOLUS3, please refer to the SOLUS3 for Schools or the SOLUS3 for Local Authorities handbook.

### Support for SQL Server

SIMS, FMS, Discover, SLG, Partnership Xchange, SOLUS and InTouch run on SQL Server 2012, SQL Server 2014 and SQL Server 2016. For more information on support for SQL Server and Windows environments, please refer to the SIMS Technical Roadmap on My Account (https://myaccount.capita-cs.co.uk).

#### B<sub>2</sub>B

If you use B2B, and you want the SQL Server service to be configured to run as a Domain account instead of the built-in Local System account on Windows 2008 R2 or Windows 2012 Server, a separate patch can be run to enable this functionality. This patch is available from your Local Support Unit (Patch 20419) and it must be applied to your SIMS database by a user with System Administrator permissions.

### SQL 2014 and SQL 2016 Migration

We support SIMS, FMS, Discover, SLG, Partnership Xchange, SOLUS and InTouch on SQL 2014 and SQL 2016.

To facilitate server migration, SQL Migration Tools are available for both platforms.

#### Please note:

- You must be running the SIMS 2014 Autumn Release or later before running the SQL 2014 Migration Tool.
- You must be running the SIMS 2017 Spring Release or later before running the SQL 2016 Migration Tool.

The Migration Tools assist with the migration of the SQL databases for SIMS, FMS and Discover.

The SQL 2014 Migration Tool enables you to install a SQL Server 2014 Express Edition Instance and migrate the SIMS, FMS and Discover databases to the new database server.



Currently, we are unable to incorporate an installer for a SQL Server 2016 Express Edition into the SQL 2016 Migration Tool. If you intend to migrate to SQL 2016, you should download SQL Server 2016 Express Edition (https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/sql-server/sql-server-downloads-free-trial), install this onto your new database server and create a new Instance. Once installed, you should use the SQL 2016 Migration Tool to migrate the SIMS, FMS and Discover databases to the new database server.

Before migration, you are strongly advised to read the appropriate mini guide:

- Migrating SIMS, FMS and Discover to SQL 2014 mini guide; or
- Migrating SIMS, FMS and Discover to SQL 2016 mini guide.

These mini guides will be available from My Account (https://myaccount.capita-cs.co.uk) on product release. They are also included as part of the Migration Tools.

For information on obtaining the Migration Tools, please contact your Local Support Team.

If you use both SIMS and FMS, both systems <u>must</u> be running on the same version of SQL Server, i.e. SQL Server 2012, SQL Server 2014 or SQL Server 2016.

For more information on support for SQL Server, please refer to the *SIMS Technical Roadmap*, which is available from My Account (https://myaccount.capita-cs.co.uk).

#### General

If your school uses both Fees Billing and FMS, then SIMS and FMS <u>must</u> be upgraded at the same time.

# Important Information for Windows 8 and Windows Server 2012 Users

If you are running SIMS on a Windows 8 or Windows Server 2012 workstation, you may encounter difficulties when attempting to open PDF files in SIMS. This is caused by Windows Reader being the default program used to open PDF files.

To resolve this issue, you <u>must</u> first ensure that Adobe Reader 10 or later is installed.

Next, you will need to associate Adobe Reader with <u>all PDF</u> files. From the Taskbar, click **File Explorer**, click **Computer** in the panel on the left-hand side of the page then from the Menu Bar, select **Computer | Open Control Panel**. Click **Programs | Default Programs | Associate a file type or protocol with a program**. In the **Extensions** list, scroll down to and click the **.pdf** item then click the **Change program** button. Click **Adobe Reader** then click the **Close** button.

# Backing up SIMS and FMS

Where SIMS Personnel is used to generate Salary Projections in FMS, SIMS and FMS backups should be carried out at the same time. If one of the databases needs to be restored, the other database must be restored to the same point, i.e. if you restore the SIMS database, you must restore the FMS database to the same point and vice versa.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Backups are no longer zipped, because of the number of issues caused by zipping backup files. Recent operating systems now allow the use of compressed folders, which are recommended for automatically compressing backups. Please refer to your operating system documentation for instructions on applying compression to a folder.



# Important Information Regarding the Upgrade of SIMS and Discover

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** You must upgrade to the SIMS 2018 Autumn Release <u>before</u> upgrading Discover. If you upgrade Discover before upgrading SIMS, data will not be transferred between the SIMS and Discover databases until SIMS has been upgraded.

# **Auto-Deployment of SIMS and Discover**

If SOLUS3 auto-deployment is enabled for Discover, we recommend that the settings for Discover auto-deployment are set to start later than the SIMS auto-deployment start time plus the timeout.



If the times are not set like this, and the Discover deployment starts before the SIMS deployment, then the data transfer between SIMS and Discover will not work until the SIMS upgrade is completed.

# Important Information Regarding SIMS Documentation

The SIMS **Documentation Centre** is accessed by clicking the **Documentation** button on the SIMS **Home Page**. The principal benefit of the SIMS **Documentation Centre** is that resources for SIMS, FMS and Discover can all be accessed from a central repository.

It is possible to search for user documentation by output type (handbook, tutorial, QRS, etc.) and then by functional area. It is also possible to search by role (e.g. Teacher, Administrator, Returns Manager, etc.).

A range of Frequently Asked Questions guides can be accessed from the FAQs menu. The Troubleshooting section enables you to investigate any issues you may have when accessing the resources available.

IMPORTANT NOTE: You might encounter issues when attempting to open any New Feature videos or Tutorials whereby you are asked to install the required version of Flash Player and/or an on-screen dialog suggests that Online Help content cannot be displayed. For more information, please click the following link (http://helpx.adobe.com/acrobat/kb/known-issues-acrobat-xi-reader.html).

These issues can be resolved by downloading the latest version of Flash Player (https://helpx.adobe.com/flash-player.html).

A search facility is available in the SIMS, FMS and Discover Documentation Centres. This enables you to locate information across the Documentation Centres or within individual resources (handbooks, release notes, FAQs, etc.). The search facility operates in a similar way to a Google search. To perform a search, enter one or more keywords in the search field (located at the top right-hand side of the Menu Bar) then click the Search (magnifying glass) button. You can use \* and ? as wildcards. To search for an exact phrase, enclose more than one word in double quotes, e.g. "debit card".

- We can provide user documentation post-release, so you will always have access to the most up-to-date, accurate information.

As a result, documentation provided in PDF format is not deployed to the \SIMS\Documentation folder on your SIMS Server (with the exception of the What's New page, the main **Documentation Centre** navigation page and the Getting Started guide).

NOTE: If you wish to access the latest user documentation for the SIMS 2018 Autumn Release without logging into SIMS, the **Documentation Centre** is accessible using a web link (http://simspublications.com/718293/index.html).

Help files are delivered to the \Program Files\SIMS .net folder on each SIMS workstation.

IMPORTANT NOTES: If Google Chrome is your default Web browser, you must download PDF files instead of opening them in Chrome to ensure that PDF files display correctly. This is achieved by entering chrome://settings in the Address Bar then pressing Enter. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click Advanced. In the Privacy and security section, click Content settings. Scroll towards the bottom of the list, click PDF documents and move the Download PDF files instead of automatically opening them in Chrome slider to the on position.

If you experience a problem when attempting to open a page in the **Documentation** Centre, please contact your System Administrator who can enable access to www.simspublications.com.

Advice is provided if you enter **simspublications.com** in the Address Bar of your Web browser. The **Documentation Centre** location changes with each release, indicated by a six-digit identifier. To ensure that you access the Documentation Centre relating to the version of SIMS installed at your establishment, you are strongly advised to access it from the SIMS Home Page (via Focus | Home Page), by clicking the Documentation button.

If you require assistance with this or any other issue you encounter when attempting to access user documentation, please contact the SIMS Publications team (publications@capita.co.uk).

We provide SIMS Documentation Centres and What's New pages for specific school phases, so that user documentation relevant only to your school phase is provided. When you click the **Documentation** button on the SIMS **Home Page**, SIMS interrogates the SIMS SQL database and displays the **Documentation Centre** relevant to your school phase. When a user logs into SIMS for the first time following an upgrade, a What's New page relevant to your school phase is provided.

#### Update of the SIMS Documentation Centre in line with the SIMS Software

Some customers have informed us that the SIMS **Documentation Centre** is not being updated in line with the SIMS software; clicking the **Documentation** button on the SIMS Home Page following an upgrade displays content from the previous release.

If you encounter this issue, then the part of the SIMS upgrade that deals with the update of the SIMS Documentation Centre (SIMSApplicationSetup.exe) has failed.

This is caused by the incorrect configuration of the SIMS File Server settings in SOLUS3; it is likely that the File Server has been pointed to the network SIMS drive rather than the local SIMS drive. To resolve this issue, please complete the following steps.

- 1. In SOLUS3, navigate to **Environment | Targets Services** tab.
- Highlight the SIMS File Server service and then click the Edit button.
- 3. Ensure that the **Server name** is the name of the server that hosts the mapped SIMS drive.
- 4. Change the Installation path to the true name of the mapped drive (e.g. D:\Admin Data\SIMS) - do not use a mapped drive letter.
- 5. After correcting the **Installation path** setting, re-deploy the upgrade (via **Upgrades** | Deployment History | <select the update> - Redeploy button), choosing only the SIMS File Server from the list of available TARGETS, and then run the upgrade manually.

# Removing a Staff Leaver as the Main User of a Room

Focus | Person | Staff - Employment Details Focus | School | Rooms

To maintain the integrity of information passed from SIMS to FMS, when a member of staff who is assigned as the Main User of a room in SIMS leaves the school, they are removed as the main user of the room as part of the staff leaver process.

Additionally, the records of all members of staff with a leaving date in the past are checked on upgrade to the SIMS 2018 Autumn Release; where they were the Main User of a room, this information is removed from the room record.

# Preventing Historical Personal Staff Data from being Passed to FMS

### Tools | Setups | School Options

To assist schools in being GDPR compliant, it is now possible to prevent historical personal staff data (i.e. staff with a leaving date more than seven years in the past) from being passed to FMS via the salary extract XML file.

Please note that this action cannot be reversed.

### **Anonymising Staff Data in FMS**

To assist schools in being GDPR compliant and to retain the integrity of the salary related financial data held in FMS, where Personnel Links are in use and the option to exclude staff leavers from the salary extract has been selected in SIMS, excluded staff data will be substituted for anonymised data in FMS.

#### **Fixes**

This release includes fixes in the following areas:

- Following valuable customer feedback, a restricted version of the Data Collection Sheet for pupil contacts only is now available. The Data Collection - Contacts Only populates with basic pupil details and provides blank spaces for parental and emergency contact information. This report is particularly helpful if schools want to provide a simple form for completion by parents so that important information can be gathered and checked (via Reports | Run Report - Focus | Student | Data Collection (Contacts Only)).
- When defining a **Detention Type** filter, only active detention types are now displayed until the Show All check box is selected (via Reports | Design Report).
- When defining a report filter, an error no longer occurs when deselecting the Full List check box (via Reports | Design Report).

### **School Census Spring 2019 Return Key Dates**

- Attendance collected from the start of the 2018 Autumn term to 31/12/2018 The Attendance Collected from date (located in the Census Details panel) is now read-only and displays the start date of the Autumn term as recorded in the School Diary (via Focus | School | School Diary).
- Exclusions collected from 02/04/2018 (Easter Monday) to 31/08/2018
- Free School Meal Eligibility collected from 05/10/2018 to 17/01/2019
- Learner Support collected from 01/08/2018 to 17/01/2019.

#### **Removal of Alternative Provision Placement**

Information relating to Alternative Provision Placements has been removed from the return because the data is currently not required by the DfE.

# **Early Years Pupil Premium**

By the time Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) data is collected, the EYPP funding has already been allocated to schools.

Therefore, the previously named Early Years Pupil Premium Eligibility grid (in the Early Years panel) has been renamed Early Years Pupil Premium Receipt and new Basis for EYPP Eligibility values are now available for selection.

Similar changes have been made to the report.

### **Report Changes**

Changes to the School Census reports include the following:

- Proficiency in English information has been removed from the On-Roll Basic Details report because the information is no longer required by the DfE.
- The Absentees report is now based on pupils who have an absence rate of 10% or above. Previously, the report was based on pupils who had missed 14 sessions.
- The SEN status S (Statement) has been removed from the SEN detail report header. This SEN status is no longer valid and therefore is not collected in the return.
- The EYPPE report has been renamed EYPPR (Early Years Pupil Premium Receipt). The report now displays information applicable to pupils in receipt of Early Years Pupil Premium.
- The AP Placements report has been removed from the return because Alternative Provision Placement information is not required by the DfE.

# **Deleting Pupil Data in Bulk**

To assist schools in being GDPR compliant, it is now possible for a school to bulk delete pupil data in line with its data retention policies. In addition to the functionality provided by the SIMS 2018 Summer Release, the following data areas can now be deleted:

- **AD Provisioning**
- Communication
- Interventions.

It is possible to run bulk delete in the background. However, you are strongly advised against running the routine at the same time as running any other process-intensive activities on the SIMS SQL Server (e.g. Database Diagnostics, Validate Memberships, etc.).

When recording a pupil's medical conditions, the On SEN Register check box has been added to the Medical Condition panel on the pupil record to indicate whether there is a linked SFN record.

To enhance the user experience and to increase the visibility of key information, the following enhancements have been made to the SEN user interface.

- On the **Student SEN details** page, the tables in each of the panels have been moved to beneath the panel label, enabling the default width of various columns to be increased.
- The layout of various dialogs called from the **Student SEN details** page have been modified to make better use of the space available and to increase the default width of various fields and columns.

The tooltip for the Copy I >> A button in the People Involved panel of the Add/Edit SEN Review dialog has been corrected; instead of reading Copy Invited to Attendees, it now reads Copy Invited to Attended.

The Current Needs and Full Descriptions tables in the Basic SEN Details panel have been moved to beneath the table label, enabling the default width of various columns to be increased.

Removal of the SEN Status of 'S - Statement'



Applicable to Maintained schools in England only

In line with the Special educational needs and disability code of practice 2015, the SEN Status of Statement (code S) has been made inactive and can no longer be selected on a pupil's SEN record.

Once you have upgraded to the SIMS 2018 Autumn Release, it will no longer be possible to select the SEN Status of Statement (code S) on new of existing records.

No SEN records are changed as result of the upgrade; current SEN records with a SEN Status of **Statement** at the time of the upgrade will retain this value.

Historical SEN records will continue to correctly show **Statement** as a valid SEN Status.

It is the responsibility of the school to identify a suitable alternative SEN Status for each pupil whose <u>current</u> status is **Statement** following the upgrade to the SIMS 2018 Autumn Release.

Where it is already present, and where its properties are recorded differently, the UNC lookup value is set to Active and its Description is recorded as No Ethnicity Recorded.

It is now possible for schools to validate addresses stored in SIMS against the Spatial NI portal by adding it as a Web Address Validation service.

To ensure that addresses are not invalidated by applying minor changes to an address, when carrying out Web Address Validation, the District, Town and County fields are not overwritten by the entries in the NI Pointer file. Additionally, changes to the district, town and county of an already validated postal address will not invalidate this address. If the district, town and county are populated or blank, these fields remain unaffected on validation, i.e. any data from Spatial NI for these fields is disregarded on import.

Additionally, changes to the district, town and county of an already validated postal address will not invalidate this address. If the district, town and county are populated or blank, these fields remain unaffected on validation, i.e. any data from Spatial NI for these fields is disregarded on import.

#### **Fixes**

- An error no longer occurs when enabling change tracking and saving the settings (via Tools | Setups | Data Change Management).
- User-defined fields associated with the pupil record are now displayed correctly when opening the pupil record from the Quick Search feature on the SIMS Home Page (via Focus | Home Page).
- When running the Person Data Output, the text and hyperlinks on the agreement page have been updated to refer to the GDPR Data Protection Act 2018 (via Routines | Data Out | Person Data Output).





- The generated UPRN is now saved after validating an agency address (via Focus Agency | Agencies).
- When deleting a communication record, all associated documents are now also deleted (via Focus | Communication).
- When deleting unlinked contacts, where the contacts are part of a communication chain, neither the contact nor the communication are now deleted; a summary of the unlinked contacts who have not been deleted will be displayed (via Tools Housekeeping | Delete Unlinked Contacts).
- The Database Diagnostics routine now matches the Personnel functionality, in that the date of birth can now be optional provided that the Eligible for SWC check box is selected (via Tools | System Diagnostics | Database Diagnostics).

### SIMS ID

SIMS ID enables a single login point for multiple pieces of software. It works by synchronising key user data between SIMS and SIMS ID, enabling a Single Sign On (SSO) experience for pupils, staff and parents. Accounts, groups and timetable data are synchronised between SIMS and SIMS ID, with both administrators and users accessing SIMS ID as their go to point entry for local and online services.

- SIMS ID Light manages users in Cloud Services such as Hosted SIMS, Office 365 and Google.
- SIMS ID Standard manages users in Local Services such as Active Directory, as well as Cloud Services where required.

A new permissions group named SP Administrator was provided as part of the SIMS 2018 Spring Release. It was envisaged that members of this group would be staff who have responsibility for reporting on staff performance and for recording information on behalf of the Senior Management Team. Members could view and edit all of the Staff Performance details (with the exception of review details) of all members of staff in the Line Management Structure hierarchy, even if they were not represented on the Line Management Structure themselves.

In addition to the functionality provided by the SIMS 2018 Spring Release, the following additional functionality is now available to members of the SP Administrator group:

- Record objectives, observations and reviews for all member of staff.
- Run pre-defined and user-defined Staff Performance reports.
